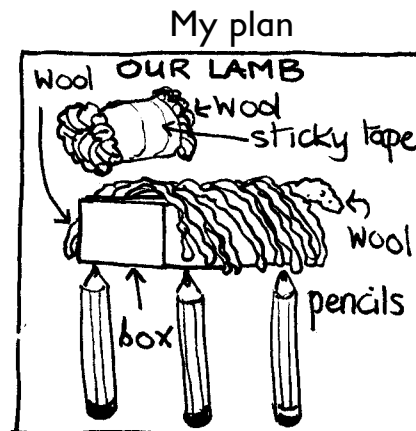
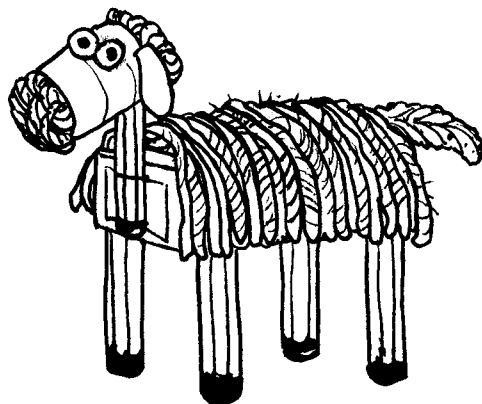
My favourite pet

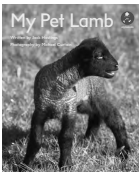
You will need:

5. Display your plan and model in the classroom.





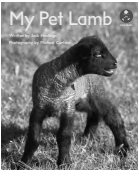
