

Using Rocks

Topic: Things and places Curriculum link: Technology – materials, systems Text type: Report Reading level: 4 Word count: 62 High-frequency words: these, are, this, is, a, from, too, it Vocabulary: rocks, path, wall, bridge Possible literacy focus: What information is contained in the words? What information is in the pictures? Using an index. Reading factual texts. Using initial letters and letter clusters to predict words.

Follow-up activities

Book browsing

Supply the children with a range of books with pictures of buildings, statues and other structures. The children can browse through the books and discuss the objects they see. They can write a list of things they see that are made from rock.

Building

Using Lego blocks (or similar), children can make structures from the book that are made from rock (e.g. wall, bridge, pyramid, path, castle, seat). Encourage the children to use the pictures in the book as a guide for their construction. When finished the children can write a label for their model, e.g. "This is a pyramid."


Word game

Write the content words from the book onto cards: rocks, path, wall, bridge. In small groups children use the cards to play a guessing game. One child chooses a card and gives a series of clues to the other children in their group. The children guess what the word is. Every child has a turn.

Rock construction



2. Write about why they are in these groups.






